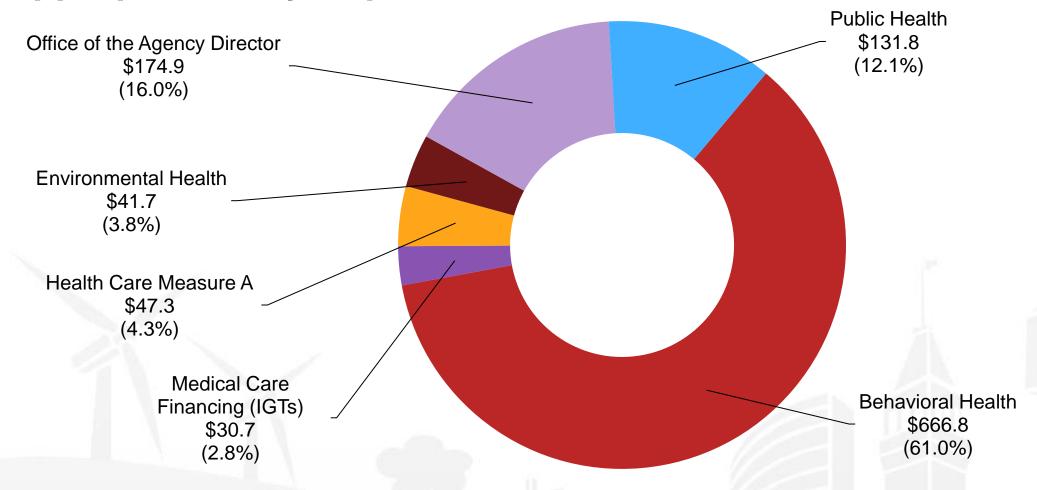

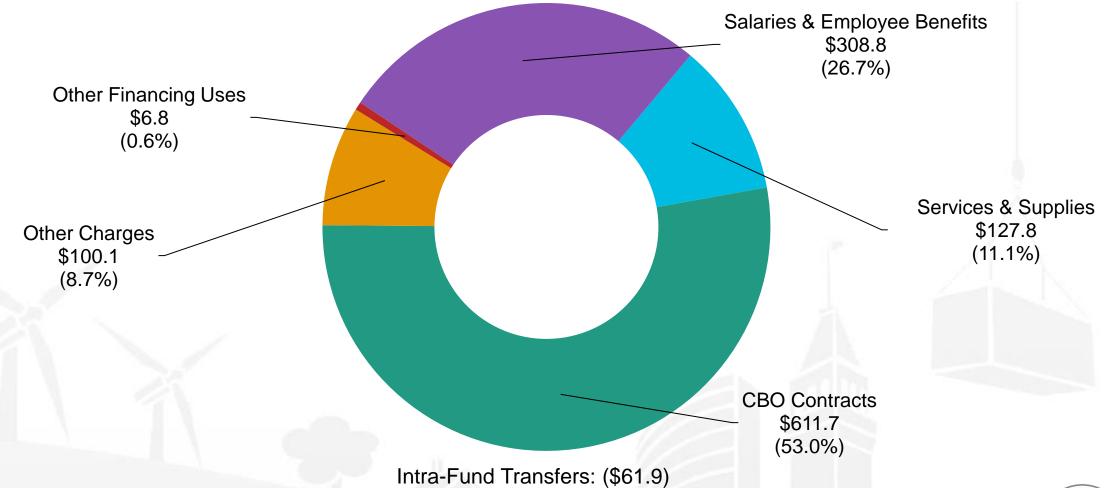
FY 2023-24 Proposed Budget Highlights

- \$611.7M in community-based organization (CBO) contracts with over 200 providers to provide behavioral health, public health and other health care services, including \$95.9M in contracts with Alameda Health System
- \$47.3M for Measure A funding
- \$40.7M for Office of Homeless Care and Coordination
- \$9M additional appropriation for Forensic Plan

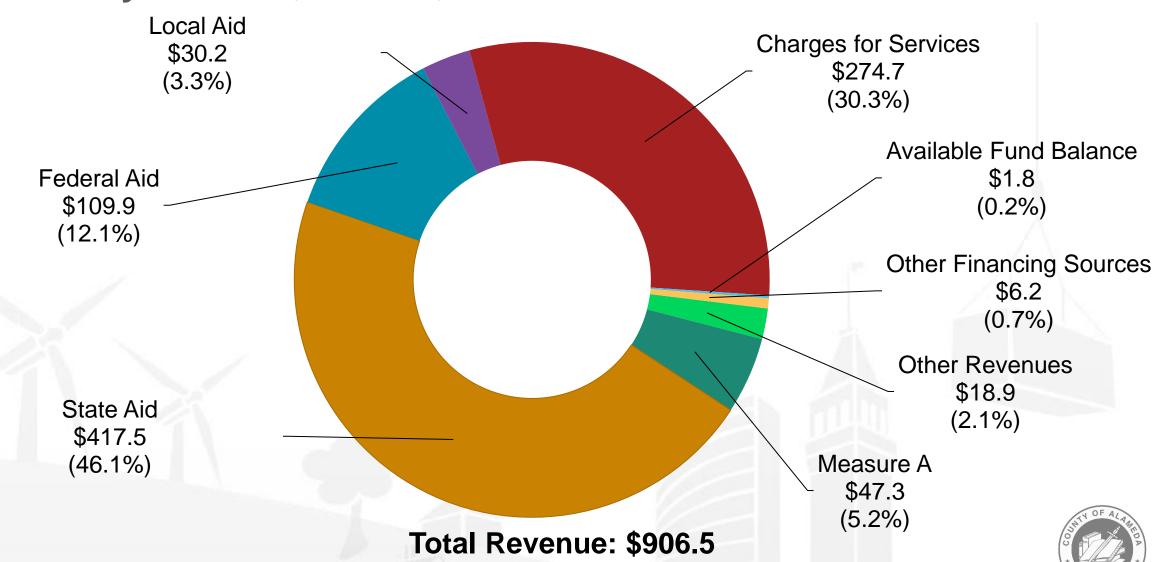
Appropriation by Type (\$ in millions)

Health Care Services Agency FY 2023-24 Budget Balancing Strategies

Total reduction of \$7.9M in Net County Cost:

- \$0.9M increase in 2011 Realignment for Behavioral Health
- \$3.5M increase in Measure A to support HealthPAC
- \$3.5M use of prior-year savings
