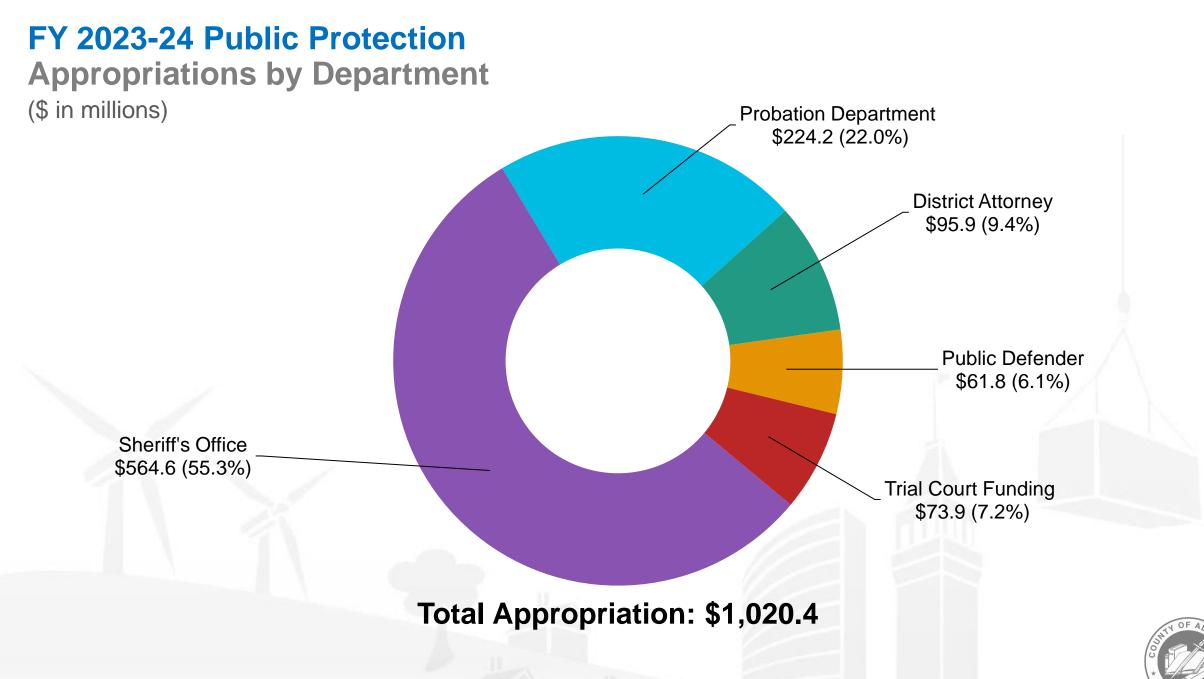

# FY 2023-24 Proposed Budget Highlights

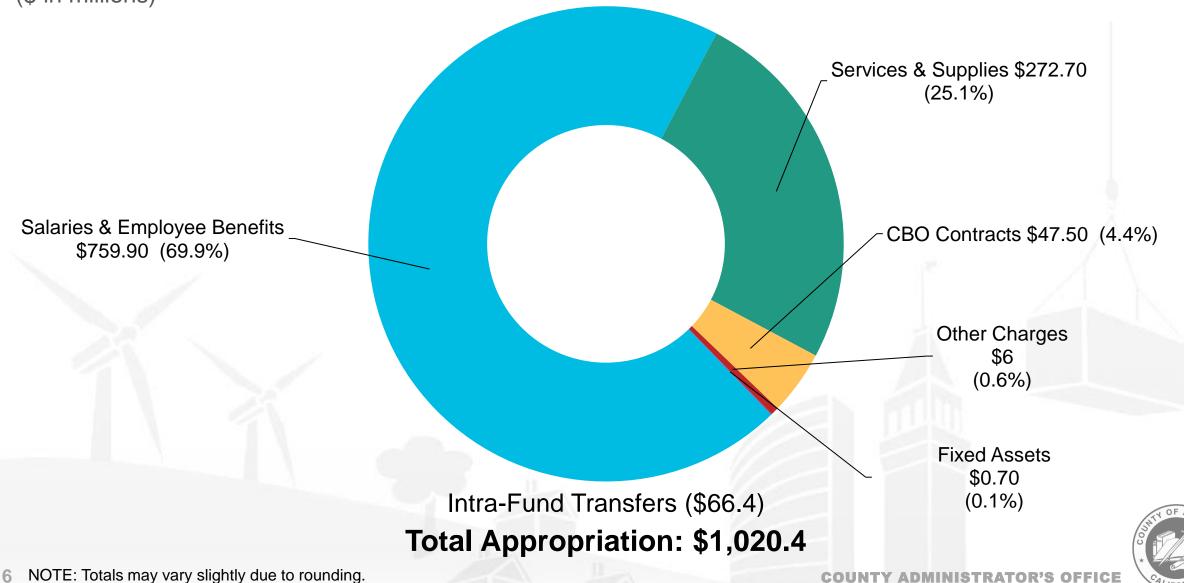
- \$47.5M in CBO contracts

- Continued collaboration between departments to eliminate homelessness
- Collaborative Courts for mental health, homelessness, veterans, and parolees
- Specialized prosecution units for human trafficking, sexual assault, and domestic violence





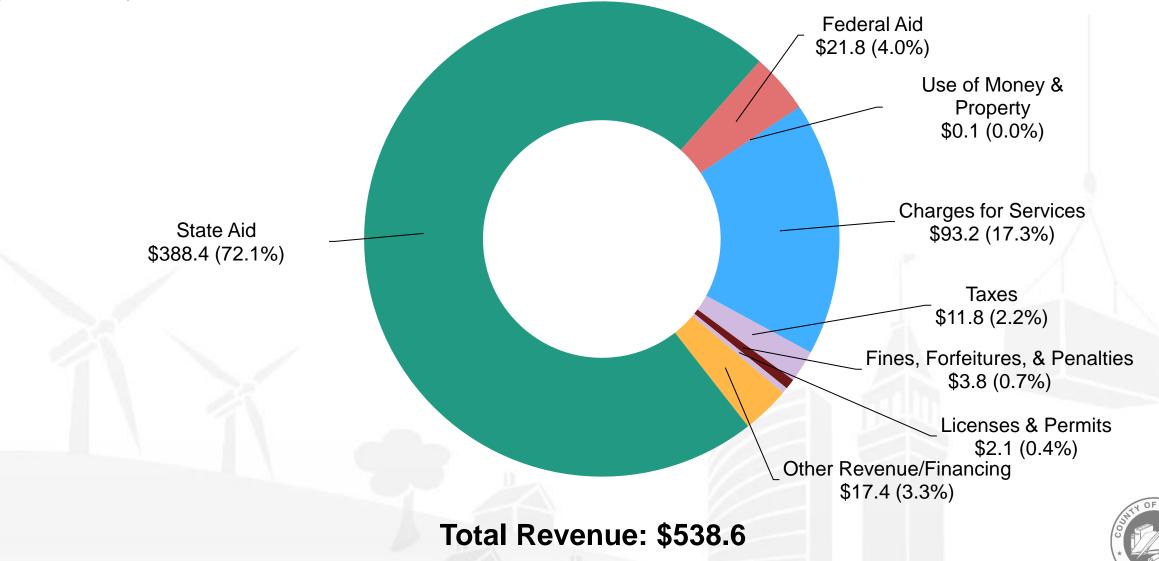

# **Public Protection Pending Factors**

#### **Juvenile Justice Realignment (SB 823)**

Probation program and infrastructure needs due to shift of responsibility from State to counties

#### **Consent Decree costs**

Funding remains a concern for future budget years, particularly for capital expenses

#### **Unfunded Capital**

Significant unfunded capital and major maintenance needs
